In an unprecedented event here on the Central Coast of NSW, Australia, we are calling on all Aboriginal and Non-Aboriginal Australians to join together with us to save a unique Women's Sacred Site, aquifer and Hanging Swamps (Calga, NSW).

ROCLA MATERIALS have been granted permission to take out a million tonnes a year for 24 years of high sandstone aquifer rock to crush to make sand for their own personal profit, with funds going to overseas interests.

Aboriginal and non-Aboriginal members of the community have come together to ask for the help and loving support of all Australians, to join in a traditional SORRY BUSINESS AND GRIEVING CEREMONY, sharing in our collective despair about the destruction and degradation that is occurring at this precious site and indeed all over this great land.

The Elders say "It is time for us all to unite, join together and walk as one, to protect what is left of this land's ancient and irreplaceable stories, history and songlines. The Women's Sacred Site and the ongoing destruction of the Aquifer and the Hanging Swamps at Calga, is significant not only to Aboriginal Women, but to all human kind."
